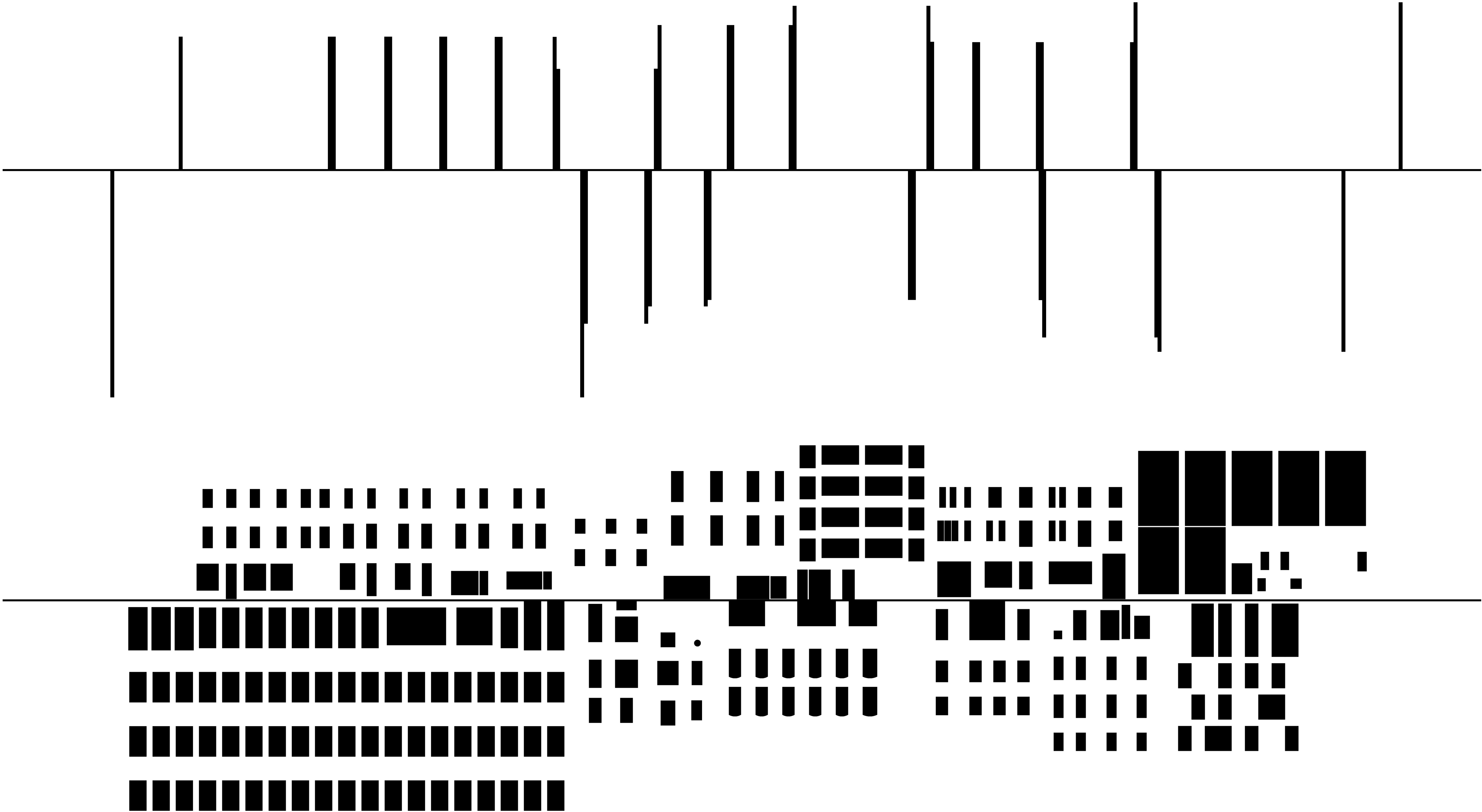


CITY LIVING - HETEROGENEITY

When living in the city there is a straight boundary between the public street and the intimate space of the house. This clear boundary is formed by the facades adjacent to the street. At the same time these facades are also a way to connect with the public space. This connection is created by the look of the facade; the dimensions, the color, the material and the openings. The first tomography shows the height of the facades. The difference or equality between the neighboring facades can be derived from this drawing. The second one shows all the glass facade openings. These openings provide a direct contact between the private and the public. The transparency of the facades is shown.
